1. 2012-13 District Calendar

The 2012-13 District Calendar was discussed. There were some concerns about the 2nd semester ending after Christmas, because Dual Credit classes at Howard College end before Christmas. Shelly Hullyhen will contact Leanne Byrd, Howard College Provost, to see how this would affect their schedule. There will be one trade day offered next year on January 21. Professional development is already scheduled on October 8.

2. Federal Programs

Since our district did not meet AYP, we will need to take 10% off of the top of Title I again next year for professional development. We are also adding Bowie Elementary as a Title I campus. Title II was cut by 29% this year and we expect it to be cut more next year. Our High School Allotment funds are used to pay Dual Credit tuition and textbooks. This budget has decreased every year. State Compensatory Education funds were cut by 10% this year and are expected to be cut next year, as well.

3. Bullying

There is not a grant this year to pay for training to prevent bullying, however, districts are still responsible for providing trainings to staff and students.

4. Safe & Drug-Free Schools

There is not a grant this year to pay for training for safe and drug-free schools, however, districts are still responsible for providing trainings to staff and students.

5. DIP (District Improvement Plan)/CIP (Campus Improvement Plan) Review

We are in the process of doing January monitoring in the DIP. One more monitoring will be done in May.

6. Summer School Planning

There are no definite plans set at this time, but there will be Summer School for Elementary & Secondary. We will not receive the results of STAAR testing until October. End-of-Course (current 9th grade students) will not be published until June 8. There will be no retesting for 5th & 8th graders this year.

7. Migrant Summer School
