



The San Angelo ISD Board of Trustees voted unanimously to call a bond election to be held on May 5, 2018.

A Long Range Facilities Planning Committee (LRFPC), comprised of a cross-section of community members including parents, non-parents, district staff and business owners, was formed to study and assess the needs of the District. Development of the plans for this bond package involved an in-depth process of information gathering, research, campus tours, and prioritization by the LRFPC.

A majority of the bond funds will go towards the second phase in the district's long-range plan to address the schools and other projects not included in the 2008 bond.

WHAT'S PROPOSED

AGING CONDITIONS OF EXISTING FACILITIES

Multiple campuses are 40 to 80 years old, have aging conditions and are inequitable to the district's newest facilities. Additions and renovations will extend their life span, create operational efficiencies, and increase safety and compliance with current standards.

Safety and Security Upgrades include:

- New secured entrances
- Access control improvements
- Exterior fencing around campuses
- Connecting detached buildings on elementary campuses to eliminate multiple access points

Major Additions and Renovations include:

- Handicap accessibility upgrades
- Expansion of undersized classrooms, restrooms and core spaces
- New construction to address disjointed layouts and bring multiple buildings under one roof
- Construction of a new Bowie and McGill Elementary School on their current sites

STUDENT PROGRAMS

Facilities and equipment are undersized, have aging conditions or are currently not available. Construction of new facilities will provide equity for evolving and growing student programs.

- New baseball and softball facilities at Lake View High School
- New large multi-purpose gymnasium at Central High School
- New track at Lincoln Middle School
- New Alternative Learning Center

TAX INFORMATION

The estimated maximum tax impact of this bond is 14.25 cents for a total tax rate of \$1.3525. For the average SAISD home value of approximately \$154,000, this represents an increase of \$15.32 per month.

VOTERS 65 AND OVER

According to state law, the dollar amount of school taxes imposed on the residence homestead of a person 65 years of age or older cannot be increased above the amount paid in the first year after the person turned 65. Therefore, SAISD property taxes for citizens age 65 or older would not be affected by the bond election if an over 65 exemption application has been filed with the local appraisal district.
