- 1. **APPLICABILITY** –These conditions are applicable and form a part of the contract documents for each purchase order and a part of the terms of each purchase order for items included in the specifications and bid forms issued herein.
- 2. **BIDS SHALL BE SUBMITTED ON THESE FORMS**. Failure to supply all required forms in this packet will prevent the bid from being considered for award. 25. **QUALITY** of products will be tested for acceptability as per bid specifications. Selection will be based on testing. The decision of the Child Nutrition Department regarding the quality and acceptability will be final.

Out-dated items and items not meeting specifications will be refused and returned to the vendor at the vendor's expense.
