## **San Angelo Independent School District**

- August 19, 2020 First day of school
- > September 25, 2020 End of first six weeks. First official grade check for students
- ➤ October 2, 2020 End of 7-day grace period. Students gain/lose eligibility at the end of the school day
- ➤ October 16, 2020 End of 1<sup>st</sup> nine weeks. Grade check for all students. If passing, they are eligible for the next 9 weeks
- October 23, 2020 End of 7-day grace period. Students gain/lose eligibility at the end of the school day
- November 6, 2020 3-week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to regain eligibility
- November 13, 2020 Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- November 20, 2020 November 28, 2020 Thanksgiving Break. All students passing or failing are academically eligible.
- ➤ **December 4, 2020 –** 3-week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
- > **December 11, 2020** Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- ➤ **December 18, 2020 End of 2<sup>nd</sup> nine weeks**. Grade check for all students. If passing, they are eligible for the next 9 weeks
- ➤ **December 18, 2020 January 4, 2021 –** Christmas Break. All students passing or failing are academically eligible
- ➤ January 12, 2021 End of 7-day grace period. Students gain/lose eligibility at the end of the school day
- > January 25, 2021 3-week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
- February 1, 2021 Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- February 16, 2021 3-week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
- February 23, 2021 Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day

- March 12, 2021 - End of 3rd nine weeks. Grade check for all students. If passing, they are eligible for the next 9 weeks
- March 12-20, 2021 Spring Break all students passing or failing are academically eligible
- March 29, 2021 End of 7-day grace period. Students gain/lose eligibility at the end of the school day
- > April 9, 2021 3-week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
- > April 16, 2021 Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- > April 30, 2021 3-week grade check. Students must be passing all classes to be eligible
- > May 7, 2021 Ineligible students regain eligibility at the end of the school day
- May 28, 2021 End of 4<sup>th</sup> nine weeks grading period

- This calendar has been reviewed by UIL
  - Students may only lose eligibility at the first six weeks and the nine weeks grading period
  - Students can regain eligibility at the following times: 3 weeks progress report, 6 weeks progress report and nine-week grade report
  - All students are academically eligible during Thanksgiving, Christmas Break and Spring Break
  - All students not meeting credit/promotion criteria on August 19, 2020 are academically ineligible until the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> six weeks
  - Academic eligibility is determined by nine-week grades, not semester grades
  - A grace period equals 7 calendar days
  - Total credits from the previous year to determine 2020-2021 first six weeks eligibility for 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students. The second year of high school they must have 5 credits, 3<sup>rd</sup> year 10 credits and 4<sup>th</sup> year 15 credits. 7-9<sup>th</sup> grade must have advanced to the next grade to be eligible for the first six weeks.
